MESCALERESS dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive and drew off on the far turn, dug in throughout late stretch and held sway in the end. PAR LADY was allowed to settled while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied and moved out to be six wide for the stretch drive, was gaining ground and finished well in the end. BOOLEANNA was allowed to settled while inside, saved ground on the far turn then moved out to be three wide for the stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch. MISS BUSY was settled then was shuffled back heading into the far turn, rallied while three wide coming out of the turn then moved down to split rivals in mid stretch making a bid but came up empty in late stretch. JANIES SONG was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, moved out to be four wide for the stretch drive but was no menace in late stretch. SIMPLY IMPRESSIVE stalked the early pace while three wide, made a quick move to go up and dueled for the lead on the far turn but flattened out in the stretch. REFUSED TO COMMIT was unhurried early then failed to menace. LADY POSSE was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch. B G SISSY'S GIRL pressed the early pace while racing two wide, chased the leaders on the run down the backstretch then faltered in the stretch drive. CAJUN FRENCH raced four wide on the backstretch, was used up then gave way.
