RETABLO was settle while racing four wide into the turn, rallied seven wide in upper stretch then was forced to steadied sharply off heels in mid stretch and was taken up and lacked a closing response. ALON DANSE vied for the lead while three wide, was used up then faltered. BO THE DUKE was unhurried early then moved out to be six wide for the stretch and made a late gain.
