CROWNFORABLESSING was settled early on then rallied on the turn, circled the field eight wide in upper stretch then lugged in mid stretch causing interference then was in a hard drive to be best in the end. MIKE'S STORM was settled then rallied on the turn, moved out to be six wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground and finished well in the end. MR. ROCKER chased the early pace while four wide then rallied to powered to the front in mid stretch but failed to sustained that bid in late stretch. EPITAPH was unhurried early then saved ground on the turn, slipped through the inside in mid stretch and finished well in the end. RETABLO was settle while racing four wide into the turn, rallied seven wide in upper stretch then was forced to steadied sharply off heels in mid stretch and was taken up and lacked a closing response. ALON DANSE vied for the lead while three wide, was used up then faltered. BO THE DUKE was unhurried early then moved out to be six wide for the stretch and made a late gain. EL PETIZO was unhurried early while racing two wide on the turn, swung out to be six wide in mid stretch then was no threat. JOSCO vied for the lead while inside, was hard used then gave way in late stretch. SEEK THE WILDCAT vied for the lead while two wide, was used up then faltered in the stretch. GEAX JOHNNY GEAX was outrun. BROOKS OPEN GOLD raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. C BUCK RUN was far back and outrun.
