BIRD IN THE STREET chased the early pace then rallied three wide in upper stretch, drew away in late stretch and was much the best. LUCY J dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch but was second best in the end. LEGAL CHOICE was unhurried early then rallied and moved out to be five wide for the stretch drive, closed willingly but was no menace in the end. ONE SPICY CAT chased the early pace from the inside, saved ground making a bid to mid stretch but came up empty in late stretch. MISSREMITIN was unhurried early then rallied three wide in the stretch but was no threat. GOODS THATS WHO was shuffled back on the turn then made a mild rally in the stretch but was no menace. SEFA'S PYE dueled for the early lead from the inside, was used up then faltered. SHAMROCK SPECIAL raced four wide on the turn and was no factor.
