CAPTAIN COUNTDOWN was allowed to settle then tugged his way up on the far turn while three wide while in hand, and was even terms past the eighth pole then with one right handed tap at the sixteenth pole drew clear and proved best while under strong handling to the wire. J W JET vied for the early lead on the inside then backed off and let ROUGH ENERGY go then came again on the rail to go on even terms with the winner at the eighth pole but proved to be no match for that one in the end while being second best. QUIET MAN was allowed to settle while three and made a four wide bid on the turn but was outfinished late while being the best of the rest. SMILING PRINCE was reserved early while three wide then ranged up four wide on the far turn but flattened out in the stretch. TEJANO DANCER was settled back early and offered no rally. ROUGH ENERGY vied for the lead two wide then made a bid on the backstretch to draw clear but tired.
