FAR TOO GRAND was well placed in second, saved ground into the stretch and closed strongly to get up late. MORETHANAGLIMMER set the clear pace while hard to rate, drifted out leaving the far turn, remained clear into the final furlong, drifted in late and was caught. RIVER AT TWILIGHT settled off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and was along for the show. GOLDEN MEAN was reserved towards the rear of the field, remained well back into the stretch and improved position without threatening. RIVER'S IMPULSE lagged near the back of the field, raced three then four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. SWEET SISTER LUKE hesitated slightly at the start then was bumped, steadied a bit leaving the first turn, lagged at the back of the field and never reached contention. CATALINA QUEEN raced three wide on the first turn, settled near the middle of the strung out field and failed to respond when roused. TEXAS STRIPE was allowed to settle into stride, saved ground on the far turn and came up empty. ECTON'S LADY bumped with SWEET SISTER LUKE after the start, raced near the back of the field, went three wide on the far turn and showed little.(Rail at 9 Feet)
