TAHOKA was bumped and stumbled at the start then settled, rallied four wide on the backstretch and powered up to the front leaving the far turn, drew off in late stretch and was clearly the best in the end. RED GAL'S DIAMOND was bumped at the start then was settled while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied three wide on the far turn and was gaining ground in the stretch to be second best in the end. SLEWSH BOX set a well handled pace on the backstretch, was challenged then drew off heading into the far turn, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch. JUBAL EARLY bore out on the first turn then moved up and pressed the pace while three wide on the backstretch, was used up and faltered in the stretch drive. ROCK A BY ZAP was unhurried early then made a mild rally while three wide in the stretch and was no threat. EXCUSE DE JURE pressed the early pace while between rivals, was used up then gave way on the far turn. CROOK'S G MONEY was unhurried early and no menace throughout. ABBIE TICKET chased the pace while two wide on the backstretch, was used up and gave way. NO PRESSURE was through after a half then stopped.
