VERITAS IN VINO stalked the pace while inside on the backstretch, started making a run then was blocked entering the far turn, waited for racing room then slipped through along the rail and was in a long drive and proved best in the end. FLYER'S SPIRIT chased the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then was in a long drive and put a head in front in mid stretch but failed to sustain that bid in late stretch. AGREATFATHER was settled along the inside down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn then moved out to be two wide in late stretch but was no menace. MORETHANFOREVER dueled for the lead while inside, was hard used on the far turn then gave way in the stretch and was van off after the race. GOLD STAR ALERT raced two wide on the backstretch then failed to menace. SUNDAY PSALM was up closed early on then dropped back on the run down the backstretch and failed to respond. MAN O' LACE was unhurried early and was no factor. FLY BY TRAFFIC broke a step slow then was hustled along while four wide on the first turn to move up and duel for the lead, was used up then stopped in the stretch.
