Footnotes

REFUSED TO COMMIT was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, swung out to be five wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive while drifting out in the stretch and drew off. CAROL'S FRIEND was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch but could not keep pace with the winner in the stretch drive while drifting out. CAJUN FRENCH was inside on the backstretch, rallied on the inside on the far turn and stretch then failed to menace in the stretch. WARM N COZZY was unhurried early then raced three wide on the far turn, swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in the stretch drive. QUEST FOR A KISS was allowed to settle then raced four wide on the far turn, made a bid but failed to menace in the stretch. MIDWAY BLUES was stalking the early pace then made a three wide middle move heading into the far turn, gained a slim lead then flattened out in the stretch drive. FIVE STAR GLORY was hustled along the inside then pressed the pace, was used up and gave way. TALL AND FAST was hustled along into the first turn to set the pace, bore out on the run down the backstretch, was hard used then stopped.
