EXPLOSIVE ARGUMENT was inside and saving ground on the turn, rallied, then waited for racing room for a few strides, was roused to go up and slipped through skimming the rail, bumped with FALLING STAR in mid stretch then drew away in the end. FALLING STAR dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then bumped with EXOPLOSIVE ARGUMENT in mid stretch then could not last in late stretch. SHEZ TUNED UP dueled for the lead while two wide on the turn, was hard used then weakened in late stretch. MORE THAN THAT chased the early pace while racing three wide, made a bid to upper stretch then flattened out in the drive. MOUNTAIN KITTY was unhurried early then rallied on the turn and swung out to be five wide in upper stretch but was no menace in the drive. MILLIE C was unhurried early then rallied, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch but was no threat in the drive. WITT'S EXPECTATION trailed throughout.
