COOPERS GULCH dueled early, drew clear on the turn, prevailed through the drive under strong handling. DOWNTOWN CALFCREEK was allowed to settle, rallied in the stretch and split horses, closed willingly and was gaining. BUCKABOO pressed the early pace, steadied at the three eight pole on the rail, rallied in the stretch but needed more. ANTIOCH WARRIOR never far back, lacked a late response and went evenly. NO SHUG TONIGHT allowed to settle, passed tiring rivals while no threat. STREET PURPOSE well placed, lacked a late response. DENOVACAINE pressed the pace three wide, had no rally. SR. MANUEL dueled for a half, gave way in the stretch. The rider of BUCKABOO claimed foul against the rider of COOPERS GULCH for alleged interference at the three eight pole. After viewing the tape the stewards took no action.
