THEY CALL ME EDNA dueled on the early lead three wide, shook clear at the quarter pole, widened in the lane while being ridden out. SWEET LITTLE CAT wouldn't load gate and delayed the start, chased the winner throughout, could not gain in the stretch but was second best. DULCE GATA well placed early, had a mild bid while no threat. ALVORD KITTY KAT allowed to settle, failed to menace. LUCKY LIPSTICK pressed the pace on the inside, tired in the stretch. BETA BELIEVE never far back early, swung wide at the top of the stretch, then flattened out. FINAL TOPPING broke slowly and trailed.
