Footnotes

BENITO saved ground heading into the turn then rallied inside rivals, moved out to be two wide in upper stretch then angled back inside off heels and powered up the inside to gain command just past the furlong pole then proved best in late stretch. I'M THE CAT was unhurried early then rallied coming out of the turn, was six wide in upper stretch and closed strongly on the outside to be up for the place. PERFECT ATTENDANCE stalked the early pace while racing three wide, rallied three wide coming out of the turn to gain a slim lead in mid stretch but was outfinished in late stretch. ALL THERE was unhurried early then moved out going into the turn, rallied at the top of the stretch to be six wide for the drive and was gaining ground in late stretch. OPTIMIST M was allowed to settle just behind the leaders while racing five wide, moved up on the turn then faltered in the stretch drive. WAR HYMN raced on the inside on the turn and was no threat. KING NASRULLAH dueled for the early lead while two wide, was hard used on the turn then weakened in the stretch drive. BACKSTAGE KIRBY dueled for the lead while inside, was hard used then faltered in the drive. ISLE REPO IT was unhurried early and failed to menace in the stretch.
