COL. WRIGHT was sent to the front and set a well handled slow pace on the backstretch, drew off in upper stretch and was kept to task to hold sway in the end. SAFE RANGE was allowed to settle while inside, saved ground on the far turn then rallied in upper stretch, was inside for he stretch drive and was gaining ground to be second best in the end. DAKOTA GYPSY was settled while racing between rivals on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn to late stretch but came up empty in the end. SCRAPPY ROO was well placed from the inside on the backstretch, rallied while saving ground then swung out to be three wide for the stretch drive but came up empty in the end. LITTLE WAGON was allowed to settle then raced four wide on the far turn to upper stretch but failed to menace in the stretch. SEEKING WEST stalked the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up and faltered. OCEAN SEVEN (IRE) was allowed to settled then failed to respond. SPIDERMAN RIDGE was steadied off rivals heels in the early going then was unhurried early, failed to respond when asked heading into the far turn.
