SUNSET SKIES was stalking the pace from the inside while well placed, waited for an opening on the far turn then slipped through in the middle of the far turn, quickly drew clear in mid stretch and was ridden out in the end. WORLD OF GOLD dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then weakened but saved the place late. SHARDAY'S LEGACY was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn, was gaining ground in the stretch but was outfinished for the place. BIONIC ANGEL was settled then rallied four wide at the 3/8 pole then flattened out in the stretch. PAILLETTE stalked the pace while three wide, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. SURE DAYLIGHT made a three wide mild rally on the far turn and failed to menace. SUMMIT RIDGE failed to menace. LUTECE failed to respond. STOP DIGGING dueled for the lead while two wide, was used up and stopped. DEVIL'S ECHO was outrun and showed little.
