RULE BREAKER was allowed to settle while inside on the backstretch, moved out to be two wide then was blocked on the far turn, angled inside for clear running room, was in a strong drive while slipping through the inside in late stretch and proved best. PERFECT TO PLEASE was stalking the early pace while two wide, dropped back heading into the far turn then rallied four wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground strongly but was outfinished in the end. TAKE A LITTLE NOTE broke in a tangle at the start then was settled, made a four wide quick move on the backstretch to reach contention, put a head in front in mid stretch but failed to sustained that bid in the end. ASK CHARLIE was allowed to settle while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn and made a mild gain but was no menace in late stretch &nbsp; NEV'S LEGEND set the early pace, was in a long drive on the far turn and finally weakened in late stretch. COCO TORO was unhurried early while racing on the inside on the far turn and stretch &nbsp;and was no menace in the stretch. BEYOND HEAT was unhurried early then raced four wide in upper stretch but was no threat in the drive. EXPLOSIVE FORCE was allowed to settled while inside on the backstretch, was ask but failed to respond. GIN'S BAILEY was three wide on the run down the backstretch, dropped back entering the far turn and was no factor in the stretch. G'S PRAYER was unhurried early while racing four wide on the backstretch then failed to menace.
