Footnotes

SAIL ON CAPOTE steadied slightly at the three eighth pole on the inside, angled out five wide in the upper stretch, had a quick burst in mid stretch and drew off while being ridden out. EDDIE RICO pressed the pace throughout, could not match strides late with the winner but was second best. I SEE UNBRIDLED slow early, rallied in the stretch, finished well and closed a gap. REDBIRD RATES RHEMA vied for the lead, weakened in mid stretch. MOON LIT NIGHT dueled early, gained a clear lead on the turn, faltered in late stretch. OBADIAH wide early, was no threat. FOODO'S BOY allowed to settle, failed to menace. LADIGO JACK well placed early, gave way in the stretch and fell after the race on the turn. MR. E. T. was outrun.
