GEORGE'S PRAYER chased the pace while racing two wide, rallied on the turn then was in a strong drive, gained command in late stretch and drew off in the end. ROCK STEADY BABY set the pace from the start, was hard used then weakened in the stretch but was clearly second best. KIMBELL'S BLING chased the pace while inside, made a bid on the turn then weakened in the drive. MOLLY MAGNOLIA was bumped hard at the start then was settle, made a mild rally while two wide in the stretch but was no menace in the end. MISS LORENA chased the early pace while racing three wide into the turn, was used up then faltered. MISS EXPRESSO was bumped extremely hard and knocked sideways at the start, dropped far back then was gaining ground in the stretch but was no menace. YAYA J raced three wide into the turn, was used up and gave way. G J'S PRIDE broke in and bumped very hard with MISS EXPRESSO then was settled and faltered in the drive. SHERIDAN'S RIPPLES was three wide into the turn while being outrun then dropped back in the stretch.
