CHIEF I THIRTYFIVE bumped with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the far turn, rallied to the lead near the furlong marker and proved best under right hand urging. ISHEAJET bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, moved to the inside of the leader when that rival drifted out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. SPIDERMAN RIDGE bumped with a rival at the start, settled towards the rear while saving ground, rallied in upper stretch and finished willingly to get the show. SHOOT IT'S WAR settled towards the front of the field, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. CHARLIE'S LEOPARDO followed the leader, chased that rival on the far turn and weakened. GO FOR DOUGH went three wide on the first turn, settled between rivals, dropped back near the half-mile pole and failed to rally. LAST CHIP was caught four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty. AUSTINS HOME broke outward and bumped with a rival, raced three to four wide on the turns and was no factor. STEALIO set the clear pace, drifted out leaving the far turn, continued to drift out in upper stretch and faded. (Rail at 18 Feet)
