### Footnotes

MR. ROAD WARRIOR was settled on the run down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn while inside then rallied coming out of the turn, moved out to be three wide in upper stretch then powered to the front in mid stretch and drew off in the end. KRISTYS NOT SHY was on the inside heading down the backstretch, was well handled then collared heading into the far turn, dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long sustained drive but tired in late stretch. BULLETT BLAKE was two wide on the run down the backstretch, was well handled while moving up to duel for the lead on the far turn, dug in upper stretch but weakened in late stretch. JUST FOR GIGGLES was allowed to settle on the run down the backstretch while two wide, made a two wide move on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch. SOUTHERN TIGER broke sharply and showed early speed, bolted in the middle of the first turn then attempted to duck into the backstretch gap, was straighten out for the run down the backstretch, raced extremely wide on the backstretch then gradually moved closer to the inside rail while being three wide, was used up and stopped then was being eased up in late stretch.
