VINNIE'S BOY was well placed, swung wide into upper stretch with a mild rally. TEED OFF was well placed, weakened. OTRO MAMBO unhurried early, made a middle move with no rally. DYHIM DIAMOND (IRE) no factor. BODACIOUS BUBBA was well placed, tired. ATAHUALPA showed little. DOUBLE EXUBERANCE swung wide into upper stretch, passed tiring rivals. SMART DANNY raced in the middle of the pack, was four wide in the turn, tired.
