BAG GATE steadied in the first turn, dueled down the backside, rallied in the upper stretch, prevailed late, gamely. LE FLYING MONKEY altered course to the outside on the first turn and was allowed to settle, rallied three wide in the stretch, finished with courage and just missed. HEAVENLY SHILOH unhurried early, rallied in the stretch four wide and closed willingly. EL PRADO'S LUCK pressed the pace, dueled down the backside, came again in mid stretch, weakened in deep stretch. ECTON PARK RULLER allowed to settle, lacked a late response and went evenly. MR. JOHN K. contended three wide, tired in the lane. ALYJINSKY clipped heels first turn, dueled down the backside, rallied and gained a clear lead on the second turn, faded in the stretch. MY CHEROKEE MAN set the early pace, was getting out down the backstretch, then tired. LITTLE ROCK LESNER was never a threat. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN AND THE RIDER OF LE FLYING MONKEY CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF BAD GATE FOR ALEDGED INFERENCE IN THE FIRST TURN. AFTER VIEWING THE TAPE THE STEWARDS TOOK NO ACTION.
