BENDANIE was chasing the early pace while saving ground, slipped through the inside in the middle of the turn and gained command in upper stretch, drew off in mid stretch then was kept to task in late stretch to be best. D'PARADI set the early pace while racing off the rail in the three path, was hard used on the turn then weakened in the stretch but held the place safe in the end. VALID THOUGHTS was unhurried early then rallied four wide in upper stretch then lugged in mid stretch and closed fast on inside in late stretch but missed out on the place. NIGHTSPOT was bumped at the start then unhurried early, raced three wide on the turn then moved out to be four wide for the stretch drive and was gaining ground but was no threat in the end. KELEVRA was on the inside on the turn but no menace in the stretch drive. SAXTONS STAR broke in at the start and bumped then chased the pace while racing two wide, was used up then faltered in the stretch drive. WHOS THE LEGEND raced three wide on the turn, was used up then faltered in the drive. LONE STAR GENERAL trailed throughout.
