PLEASANTLY GOLD was settled while racing on the inside into the turn, rallied then angled out to be four wide in upper stretch, closed strongly on the outside in late stretch and was best in the end. SUPER DOCTOR dueled for the lead while two wide into the turn, drew off in upper stretch then could not last in late stretch. BACHELOR PAD was three wide into the turn then made a bid in mid stretch but came up empty in late stretch. LITTLE ONION was five wide into the turn then angled in to saved some ground in the middle of the turn, raced two wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in the stretch. IRISH DARCY was unhurried early while racing on the inside in the stretch but was no menace. UNCLE GRINGO was two wide on the turn then failed to sustained a bid in the stretch. PUCKSTER was hustled along the inside to duel for the lead on the turn, was used up and gave way in the stretch. VICTOR WACO was five wide on the turn and no menace in the stretch. RAISE A BET raced three wide into the turn and lacked a rally in the stretch. MR. MICHAEL J raced two wide and was no factor.
