DECIDEDLY SPECIAL was allowed to settled then raced three wide on the backstretch, assumed command into the far turn then drew off in upper stretch and was clearly much the best in the end. SAL'S BIG EASY was allowed to settled while racing four wide on the backstretch, rallied heading into the far turn and made a bid but was no mach for the winner in the stretch drive. CHARLIE'S LEOPARDO was allowed to settled then rallied three wide on the far turn, moved down to the inside for the stretch drive but came up empty in the end. SPECIAL BLUSHING was stalking he pace then dropped back into the far turn, rallied and moved out to be three wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in the stretch. GAMBINI was settled then rallied five wide on the far turn making a bid then came up empty in the stretch. STILL RUNNING STAG was unhurried early then made a mild rally in the stretch but was no threat. BEFORE TAXES was inside and saving ground entering the far turn then was no menace. GRAND VIN was far back then passed tiring rivals in the stretch. ENOUGH OF THIS set the early pace from the inside, was used up then stopped. AGGIES CAT M H F was well placed early on while two wide, was used up on the run down the backstretch then stopped badly in the stretch.
