J T'S PRINCES dueled on the outside, edged clear into the final furlong, and drew away under moderate right hand urging. GENUINE PAT broke outward and bumped a rival at the start, dueled on the inside into the final furlong, and tired. HEAVENLYOPPORTUNITY chased the pace on the outside, vied into upper stretch, and weakened. SOUTHERN WIND raced towards the rear of the field, remained well back into the stretch, and failed to reach contention. MISS TEXAS STAR was ridden along from the start, raced in the middle of the pack, and faded. BON TEMPS PETTE was always outrun. VENTURES COIN was bumped at the start, dropped well behind the field, and trailed throughout.
