MISTY MAE ROSE stalked the pace in hand, took over entering the far turn, and drew away in the stretch under strong urging. STRETCH RUN raced towards the rear of the field, went four wide on the second turn, finished willingly in the stretch drive, and narrowly secured the place. FRISK FOR JADE trailed well behind the field, swung four wide into the stretch, and reached her best stride too late. GIRLS RULE set the pace while well rated, was headed leaving the backstretch, vied past the three-sixteenths marker, and faded. TIGER HUNTER raced five wide on the second turn, and failed to threaten. MARK OF TEXAS raced four wide on the first turn, and was through after a half mile. JAZZY MELODY went six wide entering the first turn, continued five wide on that turn, raced towards the front of the field, and stopped. GIMMESUMSUGAR saved ground throughout, and came up empty in the stretch drive.
