ASAVACHE was allowed to settle then saved ground on the turn, slipped through the inside in mid stretch and drew off in late stretch. CASINO SPORT was unhurried in the early going, saved ground then rallied on the turn, swung out to be five wide in mid stretch and was gaining ground but was second best in the end. SPECIAL ROYALSTONE vied for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. STREET LIFE BLUES was unhurried early while five wide on the turn then made a mild rally while seven wide in the stretch but was no threat. LONESOME GUY vied for the lead while three wide on the turn, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. WOODSY raced three wide on the turn made a bid then faltered in the stretch. ROYAL CAUSEWAY vied for the early lead while between rivals, was in a hard drive then weakened and lugged out in mid stretch under strong urging and was checked off heels and taken up then faltered. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the running of the race. Also a claim of foul was lodged by the rider of ROYAL CAUSEWAY against the rider of LONESOME GUY for interference in mid stretch. After reviewing the films, no action was taken.
