OUR EYE CANDY vied for the lead while inside, was in a long drive and gamely dug in and proved best in the end. SWITCHEN ER UP vied for the lead from between rivals, dropped back on the turn then rallied three wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground and was second best in the end. IT GETS BETTER was inside and saved ground on the turn, moved out to be four wide in upper stretch making a bid but came up empty in late stretch. TIGER TAX vied for the lead while three wide, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. SWAMP LAST CHANCE was unhurried early then made a mild rally while four wide in the stretch but was no menace. LADY SAYLA was unhurried early then failed to menace. DIXIELEE HEAT chased the early pace while inside then moved out and was two wide coming out of the turn, made a bid then faltered in the stretch drive. LEGACY FLYER raced three wide on the turn then faltered. GOLDEN SLIPPER was inside and no factor. IWOULDLOVETO was three wide and faltered.
