MASTER JEHU was settled in the early going while inside, moved up and was two wide in upper stretch making a run, was boxed in mid stretch then took back and angled out to be three wide, rallied strongly in late stretch and proved best in the end. U GO ROY was sent to the front and set the early pace, was well handled then was collared heading into the far turn, dueled for the lead while two wide, dug in gamely in the stretch but was unable to withstand the charge of MASTER JEHU in deep stretch. SWIFT FLYER pressed the pace while inside then went up and dueled for the lead on the far turn, dug in gamely in the stretch but tired in late stretch. THUNDRONTHMOUNTAIN was stalking the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a three wide bid on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch drive. SUMKINDOFNOTHIN was allowed to settled while racing two wide on the backstretch, failed to respond when asked on the far turn. FINALLY FRIDAY was stalking the pace while two wide, was used up and faltered. OTIS HILL was unhurried early while inside on the far turn then was no factor. KING DADDY RABBIT was outrun.
