Footnotes

CEASE was stalking the pace while racing inside, saved ground on the far turn then rallied and moved out two wide in upper stretch, quickly moved up and took command just inside the furlong marker then proved best in the end. COYOTE LEGEND set a well handled pace, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch but held the place safe in the end. J J'S INDY chased the pace while racing two wide, made a bid on the far turn then lacked a late response in the end. GLEAM OF HOPE was unhurried early then rallied two wide on the far turn, was gaining ground but was no menace in the end. OMNISCIENT was unhurried early while racing on the inside, saved ground on the far turn, swung out to be five wide upper stretch and made a mild gain in the late stretch. ANAAN was allowed to settled then failed to respond when asked. BAYBOY was unhurried early and failed to menace. COL. WRIGHT chased the pace while racing three wide, was used up and stopped leaving the far turn.
