BAGGY CAT was settled then rallied on the turn while two wide, was in a long drive and dug in gamely to prove best in the end. CAMP BRET was three wide on the turn then rallied in upper stretch while four wide, was in a strong drive and finished well in the end. CHAIRMAN'S POSSE was unhurried early then rallied on the turn while three wide, moved out to be four wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in late stretch. PERFECT TAP dueled for the lead while two wide, was hard used and was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. SHOTGUN WILLIS was unhurried early then saved ground on the turn, rallied and angled out six wide in mid stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch. MR. PYRAMID was four wide on the turn then fanned out to be seven wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in the stretch. MONEY SEEKER was inside then bore out in upper stretch then weakened in late stretch. BUBBALEWSKI rallied two wide on the turn then moved out to be four wide in upper stretch but was no menace. STAND FAST was inside then shuffled back on the turn but failed to menace. MCTALLAH dueled for the early lead, was inside and being hard used then stopped in late stretch.
