UNBEATABLE WIL was unhurried early then rallied heading into the far turn, was four wide in the middle of the far turn, was in a strong drive and powered to the front at the furlong marker and drew off in late stretch. MOLLY MAGNOLIA was stalking the pace while racing inside, rallied on the far turn and put a head in front before the furlong marker but was no match for the winner in late stretch. KIPLING'S RED BIRD was unhurried early then rallied and swung out to be four wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground and finished well in the end. VILAO was unhurried early then raced two wide on the far turn then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch but was no menace in the stretch. CAPOTE'S CHARM was unhurried early then raced on the inside and saving ground on the far turn but was no menace in the end. LADY JULIANA set the early pace, drew off on the backstretch then was used up on the far turn and gave way in mid stretch. BRIDAL TRAIN stalked the pace while racing two wide on the run down the backstretch, made a bid then faltered in the stretch. ALEDO LADY was unhurried early and failed to menace. WILD SAILOR GIRL was allowed to settle while racing three wide on the backstretch but lacked a rally in the drive. COUSHATA LADY was unhurried early and failed to respond. AVEC GLASS was stalking the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up then stopped in the stretch.
