G J'S PRIDE stalked the leaders from the inside, waited for racing room and was checked nearing the quarter, found room in mid-stretch, reached the fore with a sixteenth to run and quickly drew off. MOST DARLING sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, could not stay with the winner through the final stages but held on determinedly to save the place. HOLIDAY AT BETTY'S was never far back, moved up from the outside to offer a bid into the lane but failed to sustain her rally in the drive. B G SISSY'S GIRL raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and finished evenly. MY COUSINS AND ME showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further nearing the three-sixteenths pole and failed to menace. NATALIE'S ACADEMY was away in good order to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half.
