RED BIRD RULES dueled for the lead from the inside, drew clear on the turn then was kept to task in the end. CATTY CAROL was inside and saving ground, rallied in upper stretch making a bid but was second best in the end. LADY SYMPHONY was unhurried early then rallied seven wide on the turn, raced nine wide in upper stretch and was no menace in the end. FINAL TOPPING was inside and saving ground on the turn then failed to menace in the stretch. BEAUTACIOUS was unhurried early then rallied five wide on the turn then made a mild gain but was no threat. HEART OF DIXIE raced two wide on

the turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch. THIS IS MISS HEAT raced three wide on the turn then failed to menace in the stretch. MSDIAMONDCITY was three wide while between rivals then was no threat in the stretch. SWEET LITTLE CAT was inside on the turn then made a bid but faltered in the stretch. F P ELECTRIC STORM raced two wide on the turn then made a strong bid to mid stretch but faltered in the drive. STORMIN D. D. was unhurried early while inside then started a run along the inside in upper stretch, was steadied off heels nearing the furlong marker and forced to take up then lacked a late bid. MISS ARANZA showed brief speed while five into the turn then faltered in the stretch. ONE SPECIALMEETING dueled for the early lead while two wide, bore out on the turn then stopped in the stretch. ROBARDS LADY showed brief speed while six wide then stopped and was being eased up at the wire.
