Footnotes

FOXTROT OSCAR was unhurried early then rallied five wide on the far turn, swung out six wide in upper stretch and closed fast on the outside while drifting in in late stretch and was up in the final stride. SLING SHOT was well place while racing two wide then rallied on the far turn, edged out three wide in mid stretch and was in a full drive and gained a narrow lead in late stretch but was outnodded in the final stride. GOOSEY MOOSE was well handled while setting the pace, was settled while in hand then drew off going into the far turn, was in a long hard drive on the inside in the stretch but could not last in the final strides. CHARMING SOCIALITE was unhurried early then racing three wide on the far turn, rallied four wide in upper stretch then made a mild gain in the stretch. BIG SMOOTHY stalked the pace while racing two wide, made a bid on the far turn to ranged up to mid stretch then faltered in late stretch. PRIVATE HARBOR was unhurried early then improved position from between rivals in the stretch. DUSTY TUNNEL was four wide on the backstretch then made a five bid on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch. FORUM RULES failed to menace. HAWKISH raced evenly and was no threat. AIR HADIF failed to menace. POLISH NAVIGATOR on the inside, was through after a half and stopped. HEATHERS WARRIOR chased the pace while inside then stopped on the far turn.
