SCRAPPY ROO followed the solo leader while saving ground, moved out in upper stretch, closed fast to get the lead, edged clear and held under right hand urging. PISTOL PETE AFLEET settled off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and finished well but was too late. LITTLE WAGON raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, chased the solo leader on the far turn and lacked the needed response. TIDY UP set the clear pace, was collared near the furlong marker and gave way. SEFAPIANO JR. lagged at the rear of the field, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. WAJIR ON ME raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace and was no factor. PRACTICE TEE settled between rivals, raced off the rail on both turns and failed to respond. EXPECT NO EQUAL saved ground towards the rear of the field and never reached contention. (Rail at 9 Feet)
