Footnotes

FRISK was ridden along on the inside, waited behind rivals while saving ground on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and closed strongly to get up late. CARLISLES JET dueled on the inside, battled gamely in the stretch and was denied. JONESIN dueled on the outside, battled gamely in the stretch and was outfinished while clear for the show. THE ROBARDS REBEL jostled with a rival at the start, raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn, swung out in upper stretch and improved position. FLAGPOLE HILL chased the pace through the turn, drifted out in mid-stretch and weakened. SHINE SONNY SHINE was beaten for speed, raced off the rail on the turn, shifted out at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. AINTTHATAKICKINTHE chased the pace, came three wide into the stretch and tired. FLYERMAN was hard ridden on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. TEXAS TYCOON jostled with a rival at the start then was taken up, raced at the rear of the field and failed to threaten. (Rail at 9 Feet)
