SEE THE STREAK raced two wide on the run down the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then split horses in mid stretch and drew off in late stretch. GUCCI BOY was allowed to settled then rallied five wide on the far turn, was in a strong drive and gained command in mid stretch but came up empty in the end. FINALLY FRIDAY was inside a stalking the pace then made a move up the inside, was blocked in upper stretch while inside, angled out sharply in mid stretch to be six wide and closed the gap in late stretch. BETCHO was well placed while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn while three wide making a bid then flattened out in the stretch. DEVIL UP TO DATE dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch. H. C. MYSTERY dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then faltered in the stretch. ONACAT was unhurried early while inside then failed to menace.
