LAST GENERAL was allowed to settle from the inside on the run down the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then saved ground in upper stretch, moved up to take command then drew off in late stretch. PERFECT PEACE was unhurried early then stayed inside on the backstretch and far turn, rallied in upper stretch, was gaining ground to finished well to be second best. MR. MICHAEL J dueled for the lead from the inside, drew off heading into the far turn then drifted out in upper stretch and weakened in the drive. WHO'S STEVE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, split rivals in mid stretch and closed willingly in late stretch. GRAN REY stalked the pace while racing two wide then rallied on the far turn, moved out to be four wide in upper stretch then weakened in the drive. EXPRESS FLIGHT was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in

the end. ABBY'S LITTLE FOX was allowed to settle then failed to menace. BUFON (MEX) was settled then failed to respond when asked on the far turn. ZARB'S SHADOW stalked the early pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, was used up and faltered. VICTOR WACO was allowed to settle while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a bid then faltered. ENTEPRENEUR TO raced three wide on the backstretch then failed to menace. DA GANGSTAMAN dueled for the lead while two wide, was hard used then gave way on the far turn. MCCOULS KEY raced eight wide on the first turn then was outrun. HES RICH showed brief speed then stopped badly, was pulled up in mid stretch when the saddle slipped and walked off.
