TYGER RIVER pressed the pace set by LUTECE, engaged that rival on the far turn, inched away just inside the furlong marker, then held gamely under heavy pressure. SMART APPEAL was rated in the second flight while saving ground, ranged up on the far turn, rallied in upper stretch, loomed boldly entering the final sixteenth, but hung a bit and couldn't get by. BURNIN' MEMORIES was unhurried near the back of the field, saved ground into the stretch, and was along for the show without impacting the top two. LUTECE was reluctant to load, set the pace through slow fractions, lost the lead near the five-sixteenths marker, battled with TYGER RIVER into the final furlong, then gave way. MARFA'S TAXES settled at the back of the field, steadied slightly early on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, and failed to rally. SPICED was allowed to settle into stride, faltered on the far turn, and stopped.
