SWEET IDEA was stalking the early pace while three wide then was taken back and angled in toward the rail early on down the backstretch, was settled then saved ground on the far turn and slipped through the inside in upper stretch when SEVEN ANNS drifted out and gained command just past mid stretch and drew clear in the end. SEVEN ANNS set the early pace while being well handled then drew off on the far turn when challenged, drifted out slightly in upper stretch and tired in late stretch but held the place safe. CORAZON D'ORO was unhurried early then started a run on the far turn, swung out four wide on the far turn and closed willingly in late stretch but was no threat to the top two. CHIT CHAT PAM was settled early on then started a run while four wide on the backstretch, raced four wide entering the far turn making a strong bid to upper stretch then flattened out in the stretch drive. KALYRRA was unhurried early then saved ground on the far turn and was no threat in the stretch. YADDO CAT stalked the early pace while racing two wide, made a bid on the far turn while three wide in upper stretch but came up empty in late stretch. BEHRENITALL raced four wide on the first turn then was five wide on the backstretch and failed to respond when asked on the far turn. JB'S GOLDEN REGRET chased the early pace while three wide on the backstretch, was used up and gave way on the far turn.
