Footnotes

EL VINO showed no early speed, angled out for racing room nearing the quarter, responded to steady urging and wore down LUCKY A. C. through the final yards to prevail. LUCKY A. C. raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, gained a slight edge inside the furlong marker but could not resist the winner late. TAMTASTIC was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear margin into the lane and gave way grudgingly to the top pair in the drive. TAHOKA stalked the pace of TAMTASTIC from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the five-sixteenths pole, vied into the lane, checked from between foes nearing the sixteenth marker and gave way thereafter. HALIFAX FLYER was never far back, raced wide through the turn and gave way in the drive. BIG SCRAPE raced off the leaders early, moved extremely wide through the turn and did not reach contention. KAJIWARA broke sharply then dropped off the pace, raced far wide through the turn, failed to rally and was vanned off. NIGHT TIDE pressed the pace from the outside for a half and weakened.
