KATILLAC CHARM set the early pace while being well handled, drew off on the far turn then was kept to task in the end. BIG SCRAPE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while four wide, was gaining ground and was second best in the end. NOBLE ALEX chased the early pace while inside, made a bid on the far turn but came up empty in the stretch drive. HOLLYWOOD ICE chased the pace while two wide, was hard used then weakened. APRIL EXPECTATIONS was inside and saving ground throughout, tried to make a rally but was blocked inside in upper stretch, angled out in late stretch four wide but was no threat. HALIFAX FLYER was unhurried early then raced five wide in upper stretch but failed to menace in the stretch. SINNERS BAND was unhurried early and no factor. DINA'S TYPHOON was outrun.
