YOU KNOW ELMO bumped with a rival at the start, pressed then chased the pace, battled determinedly in the stretch and proved best under strong urging. COOPERS GULCH set the pace under pressure, inched clear near the quarter-pole, was collared inside the furlong marker and weakened while able to hold the place. MOON LIT NIGHT broke inward at the start, was urged along while just off the pace, lacked room behind rivals while saving ground on the turn, was taken up near the sixteenth-pole and also weakened. BYARSBOOGYMAN bumped with a rival at the start, bumped with NO SHUG TONIGHT early on the backstretch, chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn and tired. EARLY ROCKIN bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and gave way. NO SHUG TONIGHT bumped with a rival early on the backstretch, raced five wide on the turn and came up empty. PREFERRED DANCER bumped with a rival at the start, raced well behind the field, drifted ten wide near the quarter-pole and was eased in the stretch then walked off.
