UNCLE ROSE was unhurried early then rallied on far turn while five wide, was gaining ground and finished strong. FILET GUMBO chased the early pace then rallied on the far turn while two wide, was gaining ground then hung in late stretch. BURBON ROAD was unhurried early then rallied four wide in the stretch, was making a bid to late stretch but came up empty in the end. HOLLY JET was unhurried early then made a mild rally while six wide in the stretch but was no threat. MOJO MANIA was unhurried early then rallied two wide in the stretch and was gaining ground but was no menace in the end. HANDSOME BLUE sprinted clear from the start and opened up a clear lead on the backstretch, continue on with the clear lead to the top of the stretch then gave way in the drive. SLIGO'S DREAM was allowed to settled then failed to menace. AUDREY'S LAD was unhurried early and no threat. YVONS GOLD was allowed to settled then raced two wide on the backstretch and faltered. PEACE OF GOLD was unhurried early and no factor. TINUILCO (CHI) chased the early pace while
