ORO RICO contested the pace on the inside, shook clear inside the furlong marker and held sway under strong urging. TORBIN lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn, rallied on the rail entering the final furlong and closed well to get up for the place. LITTLEBITOFHOPE settled towards the rear of the field, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the show. GOLDATWORK was reserved off the pace, raced three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty. EPPUR SI MUOVE settled off the pace, moved a bit closer midway down the backstretch but failed to respond. LUKEY'S LEGACY contested the pace on the outside, vied into the final furlong and weakened. NO SMALL STAR steadied in the early going, steadied while rank on the first turn, raced three wide on the far turn and came up empty. MEXICAN JAZZ broke outward at the start, was well placed just off the pace and stopped.
