Footnotes

ALFAJOR was unhurried early on and settled, rallied, four wide on the far turn, was in a strong drive and was up in the final stride. TOO MUCH DUCK was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while five wide, was in a strong drive and gained the lead in mid stretch but was outfinished in the final stride. LUBICK LUCK was unhurried early while racing on the inside, rallied, then moved out to be three wide for the stretch drive and closed willingly but was no threat to the top two. PRIVATE REED pressed the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was in a long drive then faltered in late stretch. ON A BLACK CHARGER pressed the pace while racing on the inside, gained the lead on the far turn then weakened in late stretch. BENIGNO (MEX) stalked the early pace while racing four wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then failed to menace in the stretch. CORPORATE MIKE stalked the pace while racing on the inside, made a bid then gave way in the stretch. ZIP LINE FLYER was unhurried early then was no factor. RED BONNET was allowed to settled then failed to respond. POETIC PROSPECT set a pressured pace while racing two wide, was used up then gave way on the far turn. EZEKIEL'S VISION was through after a half and stopped.
