B. L.'S GHOST was sent to the lead and was pressured throughout by SOLIGEN, dug in gamely through the stretch to hold of that rival to prove best under a drive in a gutsy effort. SOLINGEN was four wide into the first turn, pressed the pace two wide and went on even terms with the winner on the far turn but could not get by the winner while clearly second best. TRIPLE CARD tracked the pace but had no rally while holding on for the show. HIDDEN CHANCES was settled back early then was two wide at the top of the stretch while offering no late gain. KRIS HAVINGFUNNOW was settled back early then was five wide at the top of the stretch, belated rally. JADACUS chased the pace four wide but lacked a rally. LUCKY SON OF A GUN was allowed to settle on the inside then weakened. STORM CHRONICLE was reserved early, no factor. KENTUCKY BAY was allowed to settle then dropped back. WUDANTUNOIT was forced out on the first turn then had a five wide trip and tired.
