APPEALING AIR dueled on the inside, shook clear entering the stretch and drew away under strong urging. GENERAL NAEVUS lacked early speed, came three wide into the stretch and got up for the place. TAKSENT chased the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and weakened. GENERAL DUBAI chased the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn and tired. SUPER DANNY dueled on the outside, vied into the stretch and gave way. FORTUNE'S FOOL chased the pace between rivals, came three wide into the stretch and capitulated. TATES MANDATE raced towards the rear of the field and failed to threaten. TREDINOCK was void of speed, raced near the rail on the turn and showed little. TUSCAN FEVER was ridden along on the outside, came up empty while four wide on the turn and faded.
